Because of its first release as a desktop app, AutoCAD Product Key had a significant advantage in terms of ease of use over any other commercial CAD package at the time it was released. Its tight integration of drafting, design, and documentation tools made it far less confusing and more efficient to use than existing CAD packages. Although easy to learn, AutoCAD could be difficult to master. It was designed to be learned gradually, with new users progressing through simple tasks, such as drafting simple 2D drawings. Drawing tools in AutoCAD are controlled by a mouse, and the user has complete control over every aspect of the drawing process, including the coordinate system and any graphic transformations. In 2004 Autodesk launched AutoCAD Library Manager, a collection of plug-ins for the desktop application, which was developed with the funding of the US National Science Foundation. History Autodesk acquired the rights to AutoCAD in November 1997. Originally version 1.0, which shipped in February 1998, was available for personal and academic use only. It was, however, the first CAD software to be released under an open-source license. In 2003, it was first released for sale in an integrated packaging including the AutoCAD drafting software. AutoCAD 2005 was the first release that could be purchased as a stand-alone product. In January 2011, Autodesk announced that it would begin to retire its AutoCAD suite of applications in favour of a new multi-platform CAD software architecture. Originally, the software was to have been fully integrated with AutoCAD 2009 Release 14, but due to several major technical challenges, the software was first delivered as an upgrade in early 2012. AutoCAD 2007 and AutoCAD 2009 introduce a number of new features and enhancements, including new Microsoft Office automation features, the new ribbon interface for the user interface, and the new refactoring editor for designing interfaces. In April 2009, Autodesk announced that it would make its refactoring technology available to any third party, and in 2010 Autodesk released the Refactor Manager application for Windows, a tool for users to automate the design and creation of custom user interfaces.
